
Please help your child have the best possible chances at school.

If your child must have some time off school, you can contact our School Office on 01745 852312 You can also discuss any concerns about your child's attendance with the staff in school


The school's target for attendance is **97%**. In helping your child achieve that target, you are helping them achieve their full potential.

What does having "good attendance" mean?



At Prestatyn High School, we consider **GOOD** attendance to be over **97**%

We think this because research says that students who have attendance at **94%** or below are at risk of underachieving.

We also know from research that students who have attendance at 91% or below are at SERIOUS risk of underachieving.

UNDERACHIEVING

For every minute that a student is late to school or lessons or misses a day, they are losing learning time. This can significantly affect their chances of achieving their potential.
