



This term : Skills, Knowledge and Understanding to be developed:

Year 10 students will demonstrate their existing knowledge and understanding of drama, its elements and techniques in term 1, through the issues discussed and explore using the plight of refugees as a stimulus. Students will look at photographs, watch videos and develop empathy – then will explore a script, which they will act out and direct themselves.

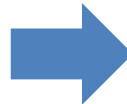
Key Terms to be learned this term:

Gesture, expression, levels, proxemics, eye contact, gaze, team work, communicate, emotion, relationships, physical contact

Vocal skills: pace, intonation, dynamics, emotion.

LP1 Week 1/2 Learning Objectives:

- Students participate in some games to help them to **understand** the rules of Drama.
- Students **explore** 'still image' .



Objective assessments:

1. Students will discuss questions and produce answers to demonstrate their knowledge of drama;
2. Teacher will assess and feed back on the still images produced

Homework:

Week one: think of ways to develop our still images for week two

LP1 Week 3/4 Learning Objectives:

- To **explore** our initial reactions to the topic
- To **develop** our use of non-verbal communicate to express emotion
- Using the photographs as stimuli, students will **create** three still images which tell a story/tell stories of the plight of refugees, communicating the emotions of the refugees clearly.
- Students will **create** a 2/3 minute performance that communicates the back story and the emotion in an image presented to them.



Objective assessments:

1. Students will try to understand what life being a refugee is like and show empathy and answer questions accordingly;
2. Students will communicate the emotion using gesture, levels, facial expressions, body language – feedback will be given.

Homework:

Students will learn their lines and be prepared for subsequent lessons

LP1 Week 5/6 Learning Objectives:

- Students will **learn** a script and **rehearse** a scene in groups.
- Students will empathise with the plight of refugees
- Students will find a creative way to perform your section of the script.



Objective assessments:

1. Students will be monitored throughout this process and will be assessed on their general and specific contributions.

Learn lines – improve techniques employed in the drama

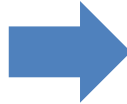
Knowledge Focus: LP1 – DEVELOPING KNOWLEDGE AND UNDERSTANDING OF GCSE DRAMA
