Mark as junk > Moves incoming messages based on similar criteria to your junk. Junk messages will be filtered automatically if they look suspicious.

Ignore > This will move the entire conversation to your deleted items including responses from others.



Block > This will add the individual sender address to your Blocked Senders list and begin filtering messages from this sender so you will no longer receive email from them.







This is where an email is impersonating a service you know and trust, usually informing you of some kind of technical upgrade or asking for your login details.
