

Independent learning tasks in Politics

Review each lessons notes making sure you understand the content. You should add to your class notes any relevant and information that you find from your text book or other sources of political information.	
Use our Twitter account alongside the Debate Club and Politics club to access the extension materials and the independent study sections. These should be read and a précis of the content should be added to your file.	
Use the library to browse through political magazines especially Politics Review. Make notes on any pertinent articles that will enhance your understanding of the topics covered.	
Use the internet to keep abreast of breaking political stories that you will be able to utilize to augment your class notes.	
You should examine the “quality” newspapers TV etc for any contemporary stories that match with the topics that you have covered and will cover in the specifications. Make notes on the key components and add these to your file in the relevant places. TV shows such as the BBC’s Politics Today, Question Time and Newsnight.	
You should work on a producing a revision folder. This will contain summaries of the work you have covered both in and out of the classroom. You should also include past questions and reports from the examiners. You should work on the learning style that best helps you to revise.
