

Independent learning tasks in Religion, Philosophy & Ethics

Carry out wider reading: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Dialogue journal articles in the library• RS Review found in the library• Additional reading from textbooks and readers• Searching for academic articles and reading on the internet.	
Watch relevant TV programmes/ reads articles or listens to relevant i-pod discussions. For example, Big Questions (BBC I-player). Search Religion and Ethics on BBC/Channel 4 etc for radio and TV programmes. Radio 4 'In our times, 'Beyond Belief' and 'Moral Maze'.	
Reread and consolidate notes on current learning, retain a glossary of key terms and scholars etc.	
Ensure all reading is up to date and complete, including extension tasks and all activities.	
Plan and/or complete practice questions independently using the WJEC or those given from the teacher. These can be completed in timed conditions or as a revision mind map.	
Analyse and redraft materials, highlighting key terms and key scholars.	
Use YouTube videos such as 'Crash Course' and 'Philosophy Ninja'.
