Please have a read of the script below and decide which part you would play if we were performing it. If you are in a household with three or more people, try out the script, acting it out using appropriate facial expressions, movement and body language. Then complete the follow-up activities! Enjoy your learning!

Lost on Mystery Mountain

(A group of campers enters. They seem puzzled; they look around trying to decide which way to go.)

Camper 1: Okay guys, we're lost and it's getting dark. Don't you think we ought to put the tent up?

Camper 2: It's gone really cold. Look at me, I'm shivering. Maybe we should light a fire.

Camper 3: I'll go and find some wood.

(Camper 3 goes off to get some wood. We hear a strange noise.)

Camper 4: What was that? I thought I heard a noise.

Camper 1: What sort of noise?

Camper 4: Something moving about in the undergrowth. It's watching us, I can feel it.

(Camper 3 returns.)

Camper 3: I've changed my mind about the wood. I think... there's somebody out there...

Camper 2: Listen! Footsteps! They're getting closer!

Camper 1: I'm not staying here.

Camper 4: Neither am I. Come on, let's go!

(They exit. There is a pause. We hear the sound of a scream.)

Follow-up activities:

- Consider what you think happens in the next scene. Remember, you have to start the scene with the scream.
- Write the next scene starting with the scream. When you write it, give each character two to three lines.
