

Independent learning tasks in Art and Design

After each practical session, think about, and research how artists and designers would approach the development of ideas.	
Look at the Art UK read the Guardian, Independent, Telegraph, Times etc print off and annotate the views of the reviewer and comment on what aspects of the exhibitions they mention.	
After each lesson record, analyse, evaluate the practical work you have done. Review each development research further, analyse more artists, then add to the class notes you have made with relevant/interesting additional material.	
Look at Google art project, Art babble, Artsy to generate ideas.	
Look at Art Gallery websites like Tate Modern, Metropolitan Museum of Art add a list of ideas and processes to your notes.	
Social, Historical, Political and Cultural context: When studying an artist, research the context i.e. what was the social, political, historical climate when the artwork was produced. Ask When? Why? What?	
Watch Art programmes on You tube, and BBCI player especially of those in the style you are studying and write a review of what you have seen.	
Go onto the internet and research exhibitions that are currently on in your local area and on tour. Annual events like the Turner Prize Research what was on 10/20/30 years ago and see if you can understand the differences in trends in art movements.
