SUBJECT Religious Studies

Knowledge Focus: Christian core beliefs, teachings and practices.



This half term : Skills, Knowledge and Understanding to be developed:

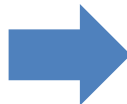
Explore the core beliefs and teachings of Christianity. Students will confidently be able to explain key beliefs linked to God, Jesus and the Trinity. Along with debating the importance of the church, worship and morality.

Week 1 and 2 Learning Objectives etc.:

- Define the term 'sin'.
- Explain original sin and the impact suffering has on believers.
- Explore philosophical challenges posed by belief in God and the existence of evil and suffering.
- Understand the Muslim belief that the Devil tests humans.
- Explain the Muslim belief in pre-destination (al Qadr)



Objective assessments:

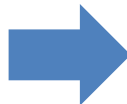
Students will examine the different teachings linked to suffering. Students will also debate the issues linked to suffering and the existence of an all-loving God.

Week 3 Learning Objectives etc.:

- Explore the nature of God.
- Define key natures of God; omnipotent, omnibenevolent, omniscient and Trinity.
- Understand the story of creation and the nature of humanity.

Objective assessments:

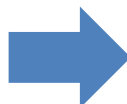
Students will understand the Christian view of God and the natures God holds. Students will define key vocabulary for the examination.

Week 4 and 5 Learning Objectives etc.:

- Explore beliefs and teachings about Jesus.

- Explain the impact he had on his followers and Christianity.
- Debate why there are different accounts for his crucifixion and resurrection.
- Evaluate the importance Jesus' resurrection has on views of the afterlife.



Objective assessments:

Students will examine the events that occurred during the life and death of Jesus. Students will evaluate the importance of Jesus on Christian beliefs, teachings and practices.

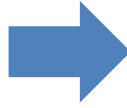
Homework:
